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FOOD GRANT SCHEME

BACKGROUND

The Alfalfa House Food Grant Scheme is an initiative to further one of our objectives: to stimulate community development, foster community spirit and promote sustainable living.

The scheme aims to support community and activist groups with similar objectives to ours by offering for tender a monthly food grant of \$100 on store items to help with food costs for special events such as conferences, workshops, teach-ins, public forums, etc.

In offering this support we hope to strengthen relationships between our cooperative and other networks of community-minded people as well as promote the stated objectives of Alfalfa House.

TENDER PROCESS

Food Grant tenders are asked to submit a short written application addressing the criteria outlined below to mc@alfalfahouse.org no later than the third Monday of any given month.

All applications will be discussed and decided upon at the monthly Management Committee meeting held on the fourth Wednesday of the month.

All applicants can expect to be contacted regarding their tender by the end of the month in which they have tendered.

Please note: An applicant's special event should be scheduled no earlier than the month following that of their application.

2. What is the group's philosophy or vision?
3. What are its shared objectives with Alfalfa House?
4. What are any previous events the group has facilitated?
5. What affiliations does the group have?
6. Date of the event
7. Who will be attending?
8. How will the food grant support the group's work?
9. How can your group promote Alfalfa House at the special event?
10. How can we support each other in the future?
11. How will you provide us with a follow-up to the event?
